


1948 siaflex – Flexibility for any application



FiboTec


An idea borrowed from nature. The innovation by sia Abrasives.

The new FiboTec multi-hole is based on a string of numbers known as the Fibonacci Sequence. As a hole pattern, this spiral structure, which crops up time and time again in nature, provides superior dust extraction, significantly reduced clogging and therefore longer abrasive life.



As with all our innovations, FiboTec underwent stringent robot-aided testing. Conducted under laboratory conditions, these tests produced the following result: Depending on material and application, FiboTec works four times longer than standard abrasive discs.





Advantages

- Works up to 50% faster due to better dust extraction and less clogging

May be used wet or dry

Due to the continuous development of suction technology and grinding machines, wet grinding is increasingly becoming a niche application. However, wet sanding applications will always be an alternative solution for certain applications, and specifically clear

coat rework. The 1948 siaflex series for both wet and dry applications caters to the different requirements and preferences of global markets and users.

Dry application

Machine sanding produces a finer surface finish than manual sanding. To achieve the same surface quality as in machine sanding, it is necessary to use one grit finer during manual sanding.

Advantages

- For manual or machine use
- Significantly higher productivity
- Consistent scratch pattern due to improved grain consistency
- Less work and effort
- Usable on all paint materials

Wet sanding

To achieve the same result with wet sanding as with dry application, it is necessary to sand with one to two grits finer.

Advantages

- No dust build-up
- No infrastructure cost
- No clogging
